What is a Physician Incentive Plan?

The goal of a Physician Incentive Plan is to improve the health and health outcomes of our members while reducing medical costs. This is done by providing quality-driven incentives to providers or provider groups, to make sure you are receiving high-quality care.

Physician Incentive Plans must follow federal and state guidelines. The goal of these programs is to improve our members' quality of care. Any associated payments are based on program-specific criteria. Managed Care Organizations cannot make any payments to a provider or provider group as an incentive to reduce or limit medically necessary services.

Sentara Health Plans encourages quality care for all members. Providers do not have to participate in a physician payment arrangement. It is optional to the provider.
