OPTIMA HEALTH MEMBERS MAY VISIT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS TO RECEIVE A FLU SHOT

YOUR PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE

Check with your physician to see if he or she offers the flu vaccine. A physician office Copayment may apply if you receive the flu vaccine during a scheduled office visit.

Each year the flu virus may be different, so it is important to get a flu shot every year.

YOUR LOCAL PHARMACY

There is no Copayment, Coinsurance, or Deductible for members that receive a covered flu vaccine from a participating pharmacy (age restrictions may apply). Please contact your local pharmacy to verify participation.

If you need assistance finding a location to receive a flu vaccine, contact Optima Health Member Services at the number on the back of your member ID card.

2018–2019 INFLUENZA SEASON

Optima Health covers the flu vaccine for members with medical and/or pharmacy benefits. We will cover the flu vaccine under your preventive care benefit at 100% for the 2018–2019 influenza season.

For the 2018–2019 influenza season, Optima Health will cover Trivalent and Quadrivalent Influenza Vaccines. Adjuvant Influenza Vaccine is covered for members age 65 and older.

High-Dose and Flu Mist Influenza Vaccines are NOT covered for all ages. Adjuvant Influenza Vaccines are NOT covered for members age 64 and younger. Optima Family Care and Optima Health Community Care members (excluding FAMIS) age 18 and younger MUST obtain influenza vaccinations through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program. Please see your doctor, physician, or pharmacy for information on receiving the flu vaccine.
