OPTIMA HEALTH ANNOUNCES NEARLY 200 NEW JOBS AS DIRECT RESULT OF MEDICAID EXPANSION

NORFOLK, Va. (December 4, 2018)—Virginia-based Optima Health announced today that it will hire approximately 200 new employees (197, to be precise) as a direct result of Medicaid expansion. Open enrollment for Medicaid expansion began on November 1, 2018. These new jobs at Optima Health will help support many of the 400,000 eligible Virginians who are expected to enroll in Medicaid statewide in the next few months.

In June 2018, Governor Ralph Northam signed legislation to expand Medicaid, making Virginia the 33rd state to implement Medicaid expansion.

Governor Northam provided context on how Optima Health's job creation fits into a statewide perspective. He stated, "I'm pleased Optima Health will expand and create nearly 200 jobs as a result of our bipartisan work to expand Medicaid to nearly 400,000 working Virginians this year. This is an outstanding example of how implementation cannot only enhance the health of our communities, but also act as an economic driver to create local jobs."

Medicaid covers one in five Americans, including veterans, children, and people with disabilities. It is a safety net that includes mental health services and, now, it promotes job growth.

Dennis Matheis, president of Optima Health, described the job growth at Optima Health. He noted, "These new hires at Optima Health are not staff transitioned from other roles, but genuine new hires, directly attributable to Medicaid expansion. We're proud to be hiring on this scale from the local Virginia community to serve Medicaid patients. It is truly an example of Virginians caring for Virginians."

Additionally, finding an office setting for the new employees helps support redevelopment efforts in the Hampton Roads region. Norfolk Mayor Kenny Alexander explained how Optima Health fits into his Military Circle Mall redevelopment efforts, stating, "Optima Health is helping us bring vibrancy to this emerging area with placing both its Medicaid and government program staff at the Optima Health's customer service center inside the former J.C. Penny at the Military Circle Mall."
